Clinical Services (Therapy) at FEN

In the hope of giving every child the most supportive and best possible start to their educational journey, the Family Enrichment Network employs a host of clinical services for qualifying children. We are one of five approved agencies/school districts that conduct preschool evaluations within Broome County. When a child is referred for an evaluation, we work with the school district of residence to determine the type of evaluation necessary. The team at FEN can conduct psychological evaluations, social history intakes, educational, speech/language, occupational therapy, and physical therapy evaluations. The psychological and educational evaluations and social history are directed by our staff psychologist. The speech therapy, occupational therapy, and physical therapy evaluations are conducted by one of our therapists in that discipline. Based on the evaluation results, we can then offer/provide the appropriate therapy as well.

We currently support children by offering the therapy sessions as an outpatient, via teletherapy, or during a SCIS class. Family Enrichment Network's Special Class in an Integrated Setting (SCIS) program helps children with special needs address their learning and developmental deficits. We support our children by providing the necessary accommodations in materials and activities to help children with their social, emotional, physical, and cognitive growth. With this in mind, we hope to help children build skills for future success in kindergarten and beyond!
