This past year has required Family Enrichment Network, like all nonprofits, to shift and adapt operations and services, with the most prevalent being pivoting to virtual service delivery. We were forced to navigate uncharted waters and with the generous support of federal funders such as the Office of Head Start and local funders including Care Compass Network, Community Foundation of South Central New York and Broome County United Way our agency continued providing critical services to our program participants. The support from our funders allowed us the opportunity to provide virtual services. As a result we were able to continue early educational sessions, provide telehealth and HIPPA compliant speech and physical therapy sessions, virtual evaluations; and Zoom meetings allowed us to provide case management services. Most importantly, this virtual service delivery allowed us to remain engaged with our program participants during a very unsettling and uncertain time.

We have learned a great deal during this health pandemic and will adapt much of what we have learned to our future service delivery; integrating virtual activities with in-person activities. Thank you to our funders for their support and commitment to enriching the lives of our community!
